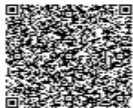

SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.181 dated 09.12.2024, under Section 118(1), 115(2), 351(2)/190/191(3), BNS (Section 109 of BNS was added later on), registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

2. As per the case of the prosecution, allegations against the petitioner is that petitioner alongwith three other co-accused namely; Gurpreet Singh, Jashan and Rajesh Kumar, caused four injuries on the head of the complainant namely Jagjot Singh with *datar*.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only one injury on the head of the complainant is attributed to the petitioner, however, the nature of injury is yet to be verified. Counsel also submits



that there is no other case against the petitioner, thus, prays for anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that total four injuries were inflicted to the complainant with *datar* on the vital part of the body i.e. on the head, thus, prays for dismissal of the present petition.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record. It is an admitted fact that the injuries are inflicted with *datar* blow on the vital part of the body i.e. on the head. One blow is specifically attributed to the petitioner, this Court do not find it a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The present petition is hereby found devoid of merits and is accordingly dismissed
