HARKESH MANUJA, J (Oral)

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 submits that PPO No.1125053800 has been issued in favour of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 submits that the amount along with all consequential benefits shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition, however seeks liberty to seek revival in case the amount is not released within the stipulated period.
4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
5. Rule stands discharged.
6. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforestated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that

eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

7. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
