1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.0041 dated 22.04.2024, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. On the other hand, short reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Valtaha, Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. He has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 19.03.2025, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
