This revision petition is directed against judgment dated 02.03.2020 passed by Learned Additional Session Judge, Fazilka, affirming judgment and order dated 01.02.2018 passed by the court of Shri Amrish Kumar, Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar, convicting and awarding sentence of rigorous imprisonment of 02 years and a fine of Rs.5000/- to the petitioner on account of dishonour of a cheque in the sum of Rs.15 lacs.

Learned counsel for the parties state that the parties have reached a compromise and the complainant-respondent (in the criminal revision) has no objection if the offence is compounded. The complainant has been contacted from his mobile Number i.e. 9653155555 by Shri Ankush Thakral, Advocate for respondent No.1 on his mobile number i.e. 9216950846 through Video call and has been identified by Mr.Ankush Thakral, Advocate. The complainant has unequivocally stated that he has received the entire amount of the cheque in question and has no objection

if the offence is compounded and the petitioner is acquitted of the offence charged against him.

In the circumstances, the criminal revision petition is accepted, conviction and sentence of the petitioner as ordered vide judgment and order dated 01.02.2018 of Shri Amrish Kumar, Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar and affirmed by judgment dated 02.03.2020 passed by Learned Additional Session Judge, Fazilka, is set aside and the petitioner is acquitted of the offence of which he was so convicted and sentenced.

Criminal Revision Petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms. File be consigned.
