1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 16.10.2024 registered under Sections 137(2), 96 & 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.

2. As per office report, notice issued to respondent No.2/complainant has been served through his wife, however, none has put in appearance on his behalf.

3. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Jatinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Jalalabad, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 19.03.2025 passed by this Court, the



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petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 27.03.2025 and is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.03.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
