1. Prayer made in the present petition for directing the respondents to consider and appoint the petitioner on the post of Clerk/Forest Guard keeping in view his qualifications, being dependent of the victim of terrorist violence in the State of Punjab, might not even be surviving due to efflux of time.

2. Moreover, learned State counsel refers to paras 1 and 2 of preliminary submissions of written statement filed by way of affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, dated 15.12.2003, to state that as per the report dated 02.12.2003 by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar-I, submitted to the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, the deceased-mother of the petitioner was not the bread-winner of the family, therefore, he could not be considered under the Instructions dated 05.02.1996 for appointment. Further that, the incident took place in 1987, when he was a

minor and attained the age of majority in the year 1993 and no application dated 11.06.1993 was ever received by the respondents, as stated in para 5 of the reply on merits, which was not controverted by filing any replication.

3. Disposed of, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to get it revived, in case need arises.
