1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.184 dated 13.03.2015 under Sections 420,467,468,471 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Gurgaon.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already faced multiple inquiries in respect of the allegations levelled against him and in all such inquiries, he has been exonerated. However, despite the outcome of the said inquiries, the final report has not been submitted before the competent Court till date, resulting in unnecessary delay and prejudice to the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the final report in the present case shall be filed within a period of eight weeks.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this Court is of the opinion that no further order is to be required to be passed. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State to ensure that the final report is filed strictly within the stipulated time period.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
