Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioners seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.19 dated 31.01.2023 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 166 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.
2. Status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 19.03.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and were directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation on 22.03.2025 and they are not required for custodial interrogation.
5. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.03.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
