VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. Counsel for the appellant in RSA-3616-1997 and for the respondent in RSA-24-1998 submitted that his client is reported to be dead. Even none of the LRs have put in appearance despite the case being called. In RSA-24-1998, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant and the situation was same for quite some time. It seems that no one in both the appeals are interested in pursuing the instant appeals.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping these cases on the docket, indefinitely.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeals stand dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.
