JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 24.02.2004 whereby respondent has ordered to recover a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- from petitioners.

2. Learned State counsel submits that a sum of Rs.66,000/- stands recovered and recovery of remaining amount was stayed vide order dated 17.05.2005 passed by this Court. The petitioners have been acquitted/exonerated in criminal as well as in departmental proceedings.

3. Considering the aforesaid facts, order dated 17.05.2005 is hereby made absolute.

4. ***Disposed of*** with liberty to the petitioners to move an

appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
