By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 08.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. During the course of hearing on 08.05.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the case. He submits that the petitioner has no concern



whatsoever with the allegations levelled in the FIR but has been nominated on the alleged statement of Varinder Singh from whom recovery of 40 liters of oil had been effected.

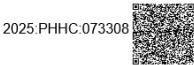
Heard.

After hearing the respective submissions, it transpires that the petitioner was not named in the FIR but has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Varinder Singh from whom recovery of oil in question had been effected. The petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents. Be it the case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Kuldeep Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 08.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 08.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.



- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
