1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to re-fix and grant the pensionary benefits of the petitioner by counting total length of service.
2. Learned counsel submits that the issue involved is squarely covered by the judgment in the case of **Amarjit Singh vs. State of Punjab**, 2023(3) (P & H) PLR 612, regarding which legal notice dated 23.11.2024, Annexure P-7, has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.
3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 23.11.2024, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
