This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.210 dated 24.04.2022 under Sections 148/149/323/365 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 66E of IT Act, Sections 506, 379-B, 120-B IPC and 27 of Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind (Annexure P-1) and challan dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) as well as order dated 10.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.02.2025 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that two of the co-accused, namely, Kuldeep and Umed have not been impleaded in the present petition. As such, it is a partial compromise.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh after impleading all the accused.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
