1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to quash the FIR No. 120 dated 28.06.2024 under Sections 324, 323, 379, 342, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC (later on added Sections 326/325 of IPC) registered at Police Station Guru Harsahai and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-3) between the parties.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 submits that the complainant had compromised the case with

petitioner No. 1 Gurmeet Singh and petitioner No. 2 Rajni Bala and they had not entered into a compromise with petitioner No. 3 Satinder Kumar and petitioner No. 4 Ranjit Kumar @ Raj Kumar @ Nicka.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court again after entering into a fresh compromise with respondents No. 2 and 3.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.
