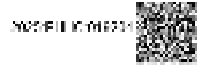

HARPREET SINGH BRAR J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate order/directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct the fair and impartial investigation by constituting a Special Investigation Team or from any Independent Agency to look into the allegations of the petitioner regarding abetment of suicide against the private respondents No. 5 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to avail the alternative remedies as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law. However, learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in case the petitioner moves an appropriate application before the jurisdictional Court on the question of limitation, the same may be decided in view of the judgment rendered by Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Sara Mathew Vs. Instiute of Cardio Vascular Disease and Others 2014(14) RCR Criminal 10.*



3. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

4. However, learned trial Court is directed that in case the petitioner moves an appropriate application on the question of limitation, the same shall be decided in view of the judgment rendered by Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Sara Mathew(supra)*.
