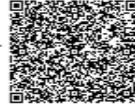

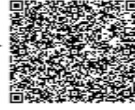
1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 BNSS with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.246 dated 09.06.2024, registered under Sections 323, 324, 364, 148, 149 of IPC 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959, (Section 326 IPC added later on vide rapat No.32 dated 08.04.2025) Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. The FIR in the present case was registered on the basis of the statement made by Chandan son of Kikkar and the same has been reproduced below:-

*“Statement of Chandan son of Kikkar son of Pyare Lal  
resident of Basti Awwa, Ferozepur City, Aged about 21 years, M.*



*No. 8872450934 state that I am the resident of aforementioned address and do work of labour. We are 2 brothers, second one is Krishna who is my younger brother. On 01.06.2024 at about 7:00 pm I was sitting at my home when Anmol @ Moly son of not known with Kappa, Koki son of Billa with Kappa, Shiva son of not known with pistol, Vishal son of Kala with Baseball, Ramesh son of Zamir with Danda, residents of Basti Awwa, Ferozepur City came on two motor cycles and directly entered my house and caught hold of me and made me to sit on their motor cycle and started giving beatings to me. They took me to Canal of khai where already Money son of Sohan Lal with Solta, Ajay son of not known with baseball and as they got me down from motor cycle, Anmol attacked me with kappa which hit in the middle of my head, then Koki attacked with his hand held kappa which hit on the right side of my head and I fell down and while I was lying down, Vishal son of Kala attacked with his hand held Baseball which hit on my left leg, then Ajay hit me with his baseball which hit on my left hand, then while I was lying down, Shiva put pistol on my ear and asked if he should fire and then while I was lying down all of them gave beatings with their weapons which hit on different parts of my body and then they left me, lying near the Canal, on their motor cycles. Then I took mobile phone from some person passing by and called my father. Then my father, my grand mother Asha wife of Pyara came on spot who arranged a vehicle and took me and got admitted in Civil Hospital, Ferozepur where I was provided first aid and referred me where I am under treatment. The reason of enmity is that my uncle's son Chetan son of Bohar etc. had murdered Nisha brother of Koki for which an FIR is registered against Chetan who is proclaimed offender. Due to this the above said gave me beatings and injured me saying that I help Chetan. Legal action be taken against above persons. LTI Chandan above RTI Asha wife Pyara.”*

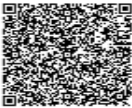


3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the case set up by the prosecution, the petitioner was allegedly armed with a *Kappa* and gave a blow with the same on the head of Chandan, complainant. Learned counsel further contends that even the said version was recorded by the police after 08 days of the occurrence and the FIR in the present case was not registered after due deliberations. He next contends that even the FIR is a counterblast to the FIR, which was got registered by Ramesh Kumar, co-accused under Section 302 IPC against the complainant side. He further contends that the petitioner was arrested in the present case on 10.06.2024 and is in custody for he last more than 01 year and 01 month. By referring to the orders Annexures P-7 & P-9, learned counsel submits that Ramesh and Vishal both co-accused have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the Courts of Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur. Even Sunny @ Money, co-accused has been granted the concession of bail vide order Annexue P-11 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court. However, he admits that the petitioner is a first offender.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. In the present case, the petitioner was arrested on 10.06.2024. However, out of total 16 prosecution witnesses, no witness has been examined



so far. Thus, there are no chances of early conclusion of the trial and the further custody of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
