The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India as the petitioner apprehend threat to her life and liberty and their false implication at the hands of private respondent and further directions be issued to respondent No.3 not to harass and interfere in the personal life of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of respondents No.4 to 8, the petitioner had moved the representation 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, wherein, no action has been taken by the concerned authorities till date. He further limited his request that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation

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dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and if needed, provide requisite protection to her life and liberty.

6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.

7. Disposed of.
