The instant petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to conduct further fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.0293 dated 22.08.2022, under Sections 323, 406 & 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

At the very outset, learned State counsel while placing reliance upon the reply filed by way of an affidavit of Sh. Nirmal Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Pehowa, District Kurukshetra on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 submits that upon investigation, Reena and Pardeep Sharma, respondent Nos.4 and 5 in the present petition, were found innocent in the present case; while challan was presented against accused Satpal before the learned trial Court, who was then charge-sheeted vide order dated 19.12.2022. The relevant portion of the said status report reads thus:-

“That the police has conducted investigation in the present case and filed charge sheet against Satpal on 19-12-2022. Reena and Pardeep Sharma were found innocent in the

present case and their names were put in Column no.2 on the charge sheet. Look out circular of accused Satish Kumar has been issued. As and when Satish Kumar accused arrives in India, he shall be arrested and challan against him shall be fixed. All the documents issuing of proforma of LOC and LOC dated 20.09.2022 are attached herewith as Annexure R-1 & R-2 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

That during the investigation no incriminating evidence was found against Reena and Pardeep Sharma. Hence the police has put name in column no.2 in the charge sheet. It is further submitted that inquiry report of the then DSP Pehowa in which both the accused were found innocent is attached as Annexure R-3 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

That police has submitted challan before the court on 19-12-2022 and the Ld. Trial Court has perused the charge sheet and evidence collected by the police and after hearing the argument from both side, accused Satpal was charge-sheeted u/s 323, 406, 498A IPC vide order dated 19-12-2022 and the next date of hearing is fixed on 14.05.2025 for evidence of the prosecution. There are 06 prosecution witnesses in the list and none of them have been examined till date.”

In view of submissions made by the learned State counsel and affidavit of Sh. Nirmal Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
