1. The present revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-7) whereby the application filed by the plaintiff-petitioners under Order 6 Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for amendment of the plaint has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the plaintiff-petitioners states that respondent No.2 who is defendant No.2 in the case was proceeded against *ex parte* vide order dated 23.08.2024. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that service of respondent No.2 would not be necessary in the present case. Ordered accordingly.
