1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.38, dated 18.02.2025, under Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.7,27,000/- with the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, in compliance of the order dated 26.03.2025 passed by this Court.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
