HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Mr. Satbir Singh Kadiyan, Engineer-in-Chief, IWRD, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing, submits that with respect to excess land been utilized forming part of Rectangle No.16//5/2, 4, 8/1, 8/2, 9/2, 10/2 and 6; the assessment of compensation along with all statutory benefits as well as interest in terms of the provisions of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 shall be made and released in favour of the petitioners within 06 weeks from today. He also submits that with respect to Rect.No.15//6 as per the records available in the office, the payment stands released to the landowners and a speaking order in this regard shall be passed making comprehensive discussion towards the records and a copy thereof shall be furnished to the petitioners along with the payment of compensation.

2. In view thereof, no further orders are required to be passed in the

present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

2.1 However, in case, petitioners feel aggrieved against the speaking order or the amount of compensation paid in terms of the award, they shall be at liberty to avail their remedies including filing of reference petition under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, within 06 weeks of the receipt of the payment of compensation.

3. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
