As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded) a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant as full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Rajinder.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** the present appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cross-cheque for Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) in the name of appellant-Rajinder with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within 45 days in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9 % per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till the payment is made. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.

Pending application if any shall stand disposed of.
