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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. This order shall dispose of aforementioned two cases i.e. CWP-5200-1993 and RSA-2363-2000, filed by the petitioner/appellant.

2. The prayer in the writ petition (CWP-5200-1993) is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 06.07.1984 (Annexure P-5), passed by learned Collector (Agrarian), Zira, District Ferozepur; order dated 20.11.1985 (Annexure P-6), passed by learned Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur and order dated 20.10.1992 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, whereas the regular second appeal (RSA-2363-2000) has been preferred against judgment and decree dated 14.02.2000, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Ferozepur, whereby the judgment and decree dated 22.12.1997, passed by learned Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division, Zira, was upheld.

3. In the writ petition (CWP-5200-1993), on 24.05.2024, following order was passed :-

“ None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.
In the interest of justice, adjourned to 29.07.2024.
Meanwhile, necessary steps be taken for impleading legal representatives of the petitioner.
Photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected case.”

4. When the matter was listed on 29.07.2024, learned counsel for petitioner had sought an opportunity to comply with the aforesaid order dated 24.05.2024. Similar accommodation was granted on 05.09.2024.

5. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner/appellant and consequently the order dated 24.05.2024 passed in CWP-5200-1993 could not be complied with.

6. In view of the above, the present writ petition and regular second appeal are dismissed for non prosecution.

7. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
