1. Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.256 dated 26.09.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1).

2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 19.03.2025, the following contentions were noticed by this Court and the same have been reproduced below:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that even as per allegations levelled in the FIR in question there was not even a single financial transaction between him and the complainant, much less by way of any negotiable instrument. It has been further submitted that although the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, however, even otherwise the only role attributed to him, if any, is of only introducing the complainant to co-accused

Vishal, who promised the complainant to send him to Australia. Learned counsel has contended that co-accused Vishal is not even the prime accused and instead the prime accused is Ravneet Kaur, in whose bank account all the money transactions with the complainant took place”.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.
- 4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
- 5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 19.03.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
