The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to the Respondent No. 2 and Respondents no-3, to Consider and decide the representation dated 23.10.2024 bearing UID No 513860 (Annexure P-8) submitted against the private respondents in a time bound manner, upon which no action has been taken and same is still is pending for the last more than five months and further, the official respondents may kindly be directed to conduct the investigation in a fair and proper manner, in view of the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court, in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others reported as 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-8), within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks by passing a speaking order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
