2. Prayer in the present petition(s) filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus*

for directing respondent No.1-the Financial Commissioner, Haryana to decide the revision petitions bearing ***ROR No.89 of 2023*** and ***ROR No.90 of 2023***, both titled as ***Smt. Kaushalya Devi v. Satwant Singh (since deceased) and others***, in a time bound manner.

3. Pursuant to the advance copy of petition having been supplied to learned State counsel, she submits that the afore-said revision petition(s) are pending consideration before the learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana for 19.03.2025. However, the petitioners herein had filed an application seeking impleadment therein and in all probability, the said application for impleadment would be considered and decided by the learned Financial Commissioner along with the main revision petition(s) on 19.03.2025 itself and in any case, not beyond a period of six weeks thereafter.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the afore-said course of action being adopted.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the respective parties, both the petitions i.e. ***CWP-7426-2025*** and ***CWP-7446-2025*** (titled as ***Neeraj Mittal and another vs State of Haryana and others***), are disposed of, accordingly.
