1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-19).

2. On 18.03.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Inter alia submits that petitioner applied for the post of Constable pursuant to advertisement of 2015. He was not granted marks of NCC. His matter travelled to Division Bench of this Court by way of LPA-739-2023. On the directions of Division Bench of this Court, the respondent permitted him to join. He joined on 12.03.2024. His colleagues who joined in 2017 are getting higher salary as well as enjoying seniority. There was no fault on his part still respondent by impugned order has rejected his claim qua seniority and pay fixation.

3. On being confronted with order dated 07.02.2025 passed by this Court in **CWP-3518-2025, Dharamvir Singh vs. State of Haryana and others**, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl.
