1. By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-authorities to take necessary action/decision on the proposals dated 26.03.2024 (Annexure P-12) and dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-16) submitted by them in response to their notices dated



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24.03.2024 (Annexure P-11) and dated 14.02.2025 (Annexure P-15).

2. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5-HSVP and submits that the petitioners have already made representation/proposal dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-16) to respondent No.5, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with the concerns/grievances and pass an appropriate order on the said representation/proposal.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, submits that the said representation/proposal shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Estate Officer-II, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, to look into the pending representation/proposal dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-16) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law,

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preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
