1. This is petition for anticipatory bail has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), in a case arising out of FIR No.16 dated 24.02.2025 under Sections 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 61(2) of BNS, Police Station City Daba, District Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 07.04.2025, the petitioners were admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioners were also directed to cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

3. On the instructions of ASI Rajinder Singh, who is present in the Court, learned State Counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 07.04.2025. He has further stated that the custody of the petitioners is not required for further investigation.



4. Learned counsel for the complainant has contended that some sections which are made out with regard to conduct of the petitioners have not been added by the investigating agency. Qua above-mentioned plea, the complainant shall be at liberty to raise the same before the learned trial Court.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 07.04.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.
