JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (Oral)

1. The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondentas No.1 to 3 to deliver the possession of the land in dispute to the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that in view of the judgment dated 02.03.2017 wherein it has been held that the petitioners are in joint possession alongwith the private respondents, proceedings under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. are not maintainable.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the private respondents has not disputed the factual position that both the sides have been found to be in joint possession.

4. In view of the above, the petitioners are at liberty to approach the Sub Divisional Magistrate concerned for review/recall/modification of the order dated 09.05.2012. The concerned authority shall adjudicate upon any application moved by eight side within a period of two weeks of moving such application.
