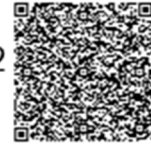

The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to notionally fix the petitioner's salary/pay scale at par with her junior with effect from 06.03.2019, and release the arrears of salary along with interest in terms of orders dated 02.05.2024 and 10.07.2024, Annexure P-3, wherein persons junior to the petitioner have been granted the same benefit.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make a fresh representation before respondent No.2 raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, any such representation is filed by the petitioner within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.2-Director, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within three months of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case, the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹ 50,000 to the petitioner.
