1. The instant petition has been filed seeking direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.290 dated 11.12.2024, under Sections 76, 115(s) & 190 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel while placing reliance upon the affidavit dated 22.04.2025 filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, submits that in the present case, respondent No.5, namely Kuldeep Kaur was arrested on 10.04.2025. Thereafter, the police of Tanda, District Hoshiarpur has been continuously conducted raids at the residential houses of respondents No.4, 6 to 9 to arrest them. He has further submitted that out of a total of 06 accused, 03 have been arrested. Moreover, duty officer as also PCR Official Unit, Tanda have been instructed to maintain

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vigilance over the residential house of the petitioner to ensure the safety and protection of the petitioner and her family members.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the facts mentioned in the affidavit and submissions made by learned State counsel.
- 4. In view of above, the present petition is dismissed as rendered infructuous.
- 5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
