This petition has been preferred by the petitioner, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 & 2 as she along with her family members are apprehending threats at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5 for falsely implicating her aunt in some false and frivolous case under NDPS Act.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has preferred a representation/complaint dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-4) to respondents No.2 to 4 but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into her representation/complaint and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
