Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are willing to settle the matter with the respondent-Bank and would deposit the overdue amount by 11:00 AM tomorrow i.e. 29.04.2025.

Learned counsel for the respondent-Bank, who appears through video conferencing submits that the overdue amount is Rs.7,86,000/- and in the event of the petitioners making payment of this amount by 11:00 AM tomorrow i.e. 29.04.2025, the auction of the secured asset would be deferred and the loan account of the petitioners would be regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes that the petitioners would pay a sum of Rs.7,86,000/- by 11:00 AM tomorrow i.e. 29.04.2025.

In view of the above, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with the direction that in the event of the petitioners making payment of Rs.7,86,000/- by 11:00 AM tomorrow i.e. 29.04.2025, their loan account would be

regularized and the auction of the secured asset which is fixed for tomorrow i.e. 29.4.2025 would also be deferred. However, in the event of the petitioners not making the payment by 11:00 AM tomorrow i.e. 29.04.2025, the respondent-Bank would be at liberty to conduct the auction of the secured asset.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
