SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed primarily aggrieved by the in-action of the authorities to establish Sewerage Treatment Plant at Gobind Vihar Colony, Longowal, District Sangrur.

2. In the reply filed on behalf of Municipal Council, Longowal (respondent No.6), it is stated that the said Plant has been installed in the said Colony and the consent to operate the same has been issued. The Certificate



dated 21.08.2023 issued by the Punjab Pollution Control Board has been produced today by learned counsel for respondent No.6, which is taken on record as ‘Mark X’.

3. It is also informed that the said Plant has become functional.
4. In view of the above revelations, which are not denied by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition become infructuous and is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court, in case the aforesaid Plant is non-functional.
