1. By this order, two appeals i.e., RSA-1288-1999 and RSA-638-1999 shall stand disposed of.

2. Against the judgments and decrees dated 24.02.1996 passed by the trial Court and 14.11.1998 passed by the First Appellate Court in a suit which was instituted in the year 1991, two present appeals have been filed.

3. First appeal i.e., RSA-638-1999 has been filed by the Panjab University in which vide order dated 05.03.1999, operation of the judgment and decree under appeal was stayed. The said stay has been continuing till date. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent in spite of notice having been issued to the respondent in the said case.



4. Second appeal i.e., RSA-1288-1999 has been filed by the plaintiff-S.C. Kashyap. No one has come forward to pursue the said appeal as well and as it has been stated hereinabove, the suit was filed in the year 1991 and no one on behalf of the plaintiff is pursuing the appeal filed by the plaintiff or is opposing the appeal filed by the Panjab University.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Panjab University has submitted that in the said circumstances, appeal i.e., RSA-638-1999 be disposed of but liberty be granted to the appellant to revive the same in case the respondent files any execution application or approaches the office of the University to seek implementation of the impugned judgment.

6. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, RSA-638-1999 is disposed of with liberty aforesaid. Liberty is also granted to the respondent to revive the same in case any cause survives.

7. Since, no one has come forward to pursue RSA-1288-1999, thus, the said appeal is also disposed of granting liberty to the appellant to revive the same in case any cause survives.

8. Registry is directed to send a copy of the present order to the appellant in RSA-1288-1999 at the address given in the memo of parties.

9. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
