1. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant on the previous date has submitted that appellant is not in touch with the counsel, so notice was issued. Appellants No. 1(A), 1(C) & 1(D) are duly served but none has come present. Even the counsel has submitted that none of the appellants has approached the counsel. It seems that appellants are not interested in pursuing the instant appeal.
