The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in a case bearing FIR No.830 dated 22.12.2024 under Sections 305/317(2)/347(1) BNS, 2023 (Sections 338/336(3)/340(2)/61(2) BNS, 2023 added later on) registered at Police Station Gurugram Sadar, District Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 21.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that two co-accused, namely, Sombir and Kapil have been granted the concession of regular bail.

The learned State counsel, on the other hand, contends that, though, the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not co-operating in the same.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case as also the fact that two co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail, no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner into custody.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 21.03.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
