Challenge in the present petition is to the action of the respondents, whereby the respondents without there being any cogent reason are not releasing the complete retiral benefits i.e. Leave Encashment and GIS etc.; with a further prayer to direct the respondents to revise the pay/pension of the petitioner by extending the benefit of 2nd and 3rd ACPs w.e.f. 01.09.2008 and 01.09.2014 respectively and to pay the arrears alongwith interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that several representations in this regard, including the last one dated 30.10.2022, have been submitted by the petitioner; but the respondents have neither taken any action thereupon nor have they released the outstanding dues of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and informs on instructions from Hardeep Singh, Assistant, Department of Women and Child Development, Haryana that the matter is under active consideration of the Authorities concerned and a decision shall be taken within a period of two months and the admissible dues will also be paid to petitioner, as per the decision within a further period of two months thereafter.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

Needless to say that the respondents shall remain bound by the statement made today in Court by the learned State Counsel.
