1. The prayer made in the present petition to promote the petitioner to Treasury Officer from the post of Senior Assistant, from the date of his juniors, might not due to efflux of time, even be surviving.

Learned State counsel refers to paras 1 and 2 of the written statement dated 20.11.2003 filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, that the name of the petitioner was considered by the Departmental Promotion Committee, however, due to adverse remarks in his confidential report for the year, 1997-98, which was also duly conveyed to him, was not approved for promotion. No representation had been submitted by him against the same. There was no rebuttal by filing any replication to the above.

3. Disposed of, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to get it revived, in case *lis* still subsists.
