By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
765	13.07.2023	21 (b) of NDPS Act, 1985	Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the orders dated 07.04.2025 and 05.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide orders dated 07.04.2025 and 05.05.2025.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dinesh Kumar, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 07.04.2025, following order was passed:

“ 3. Heard.

4. After considering the rival contentions and perusing the record, it is observed that the petitioner has been nominated in the present case on the disclosure statement of co-accused Jangir Singh from whom 6.44 grams of heroin was recovered. On query, it is stated by the Investigating officer present in Court, that except for the disclosure statement, there is nothing substantive against the petitioner as of now. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there had not been any recovery from the petitioner in the earlier cases registered against him wherein he is already on bail.

5. Be it the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.

7. List on 05.05.2025. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the orders dated 07.04.2025 and 05.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide orders dated 07.04.2025 and 05.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave

the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
