1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondent no.3, who is raiding and searching house and shop of the petitioner and also threatening to demolish the same.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the petitioner was convicted in a case under NDPS Act and after having been convicted, she never indulged in any illegal activity. He submits that despite this fact, the police is intentionally harassing her and also threatening to demolish her house and shop.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and at the outset submits, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, that neither there is any complaint against the petitioner nor she is required by the police in any case. He submits that the present petition has been filed by

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the petitioner totally on the basis of assumptions and presumptions. He further submits that the contention regarding demolition of house and shop of the petitioner by the police is also misconceived and no such auction has ever been taken by the police. He also undertakes, on instructions, that the police would not demolish house and shop of the petitioner, as alleged by her in this petition.

5. In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, nothing survives in this petition and hence, the same is hereby disposed of as such.
