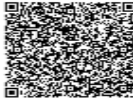

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to produce the alleged detainee namely Shalu, who has been detained in the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. Mr. Saurabh Bajaj, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 by filing his memo of appearance, which is taken on record.



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3. In compliance of the order dated 20.03.2025 passed by this Court, the respondent No.3 has produced alleged detainee Shalu wife of the petitioner before this Court.

4. I have interacted with Shalu, alleged detainee and she submits that she is aged about 22 years and has studied up to 12 standard and at present she is staying with Seema, respondent No.4, out of her own free will. In fact Seema, respondent No.4 is her mother and she wishes to stay with her only.

5. In view of the statement made by Shalu, alleged detainee, no further orders are required to be passed in this case and the petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Shalu, alleged detainee is major and is permitted to go a place for her choice.

7. Needless to observe that the parties to the litigation shall at liberty to avail their alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
