1. Second Regular Bail Petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. (483 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023), for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, during the pendency of trial, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

2. Learned State counsel produces the custody certificate dated 01.09.2025 in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place. A copy thereof has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the State contends that out of 20 prosecution witnesses, 10 have already been examined, 09 have been given up and only 02 are yet to be examined.

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5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition and restricts his prayer only to the extent that appropriate directions may be issued for the expeditious disposal of the case.

6. Accordingly, petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, learned trial Court is directed to look into the feasibility of the expeditious disposal of the case in accordance with law.
