The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to quash the impugned order dated 04.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by 1d. Addl. Sessions Judge, Fazilka in Crl. Appeal No.87 of 2024 titled as ***Krishan Lal Garg Vs. Sajan Ahuja*** in Crl. complaint No. NACT 143 of 2019 dated 22.2.2019 under section 138 of the N.I. Act read with section 420 IPC, titled as ***Krishan Lal Garg Vs. Sajan Ahuja*** whereby the application filed by the petitioner for waiving off 20% of compensation amount as awarded by 1d. trial court has been dismissed wrongly, illegally and without appreciating the actual facts of the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner though admitting the fact that in an earlier CRM-M-37966-2024, he failed to disclose the filing of earlier

application for extension of time for depositing the 20 % amount out of the compensation amount. He prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

He would further request for one week's time to deposit the 20 % of the amount of compensation.

To check his *bona fide* and considering the request to be genuine as one last opportunity, this Court directed the trial Court to accept the amount of 20% out of the compensation as ordered, if the petitioner deposits the same within a period of one week from today itself i.e., latest by 02.04.2025.

It is made clear that it should be treated as last and final opportunity.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
