AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. On the previous date one CRM-22691-2025 was filed seeking exemption to petitioner from physical appearance before this Court and be allowed to appear through Video Conferencing.
2. Today, nobody has appeared personally or through V.C. Learned counsel for petitioner is not appearing for the last three dates i.e. 08.04.2025, 23.05.2025 and 29.05.2025. Anticipatory bail petition is pending since 03.04.2024. Initially, petitioner was granted interim relief and the same stood vacated as per order date 17.03.2025, when even learned counsel for petitioner pleaded no instructions. Since, nobody is appearing either personally or through counsel, I do not find it appropriate to further adjourn the case time and again. Therefore, present anticipatory bail petition stands dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
3. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
