1. This is an application under Order XXII Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC for bringing on record the LRs of deceased appellant.
2. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit and the averments mentioned in the application, the present application is allowed subject to all just exceptions and the persons mentioned in paragraph 4 of the application are ordered to be impleaded as the legal representatives of the appellant.



3. It is clarified that this Court has not adjudicated upon the right of the estate of the appellant and the LR's have been impleaded only to pursue the present appeal.
