1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to timely pay the salary of the petitioners in the regular pay grade.

2. Learned Sr. counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners fairly submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioners are getting salary regularly. However, he submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for the grant of minimum of the pay scale as given to the District Special Educators in terms of Annexure P-2. He further submits that as far as

the regularization of the services of the petitioners is concerned, the issue may be left open to be taken up at the appropriate stage in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. In view of the abovesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider and decide the case of the petitioners for grant of minimum of the pay scale, as has been given to the regularly employed teachers in the Education Department, as per rule/law, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
