1. By way of present appeal, challenge has been laid to the judgments and decrees dated 23.08.1996 and 17.11.1998 passed by the Courts below, whereby, in a suit for recovery of Rs.31,350/- from the appellant-defendant, the Court decreed the suit in favour of the respondents-plaintiffs along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. The appellant-defendant being aggrieved thereof filed the present appeal, which was admitted for final hearing on 17.08.1999 and has now been listed for hearing.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that despite making all sincere efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the appellant and thus, is not in a position to make his submissions. He also submits that even the registered letter posted to intimate the appellant has been received back undelivered.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, the appellant would be at liberty to approach this Court again, seeking restoration in case any cause survives.
5. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
