1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to the Court of Additional District Judge, Patiala (wrongly mentioned as 'Additional District Judge, Sangrur' in the head note of the petition) to expedite the hearing of the application under Section 36(2) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') in the objection petition under Section 34 of the Act filed by the petitioner-NHAI pending adjudication before the Court of learned Additional District Judge.

2. As per the report of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala, application under Section 36(2) of the Act has been disposed of on 28.08.2025.
